- Sequence familiar routines

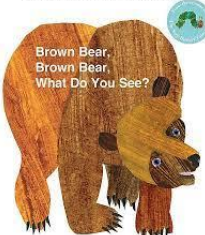
Phonics

- putting our hand up in group times when asking or answering a question

We will be learning to:

- start to recognise & manage our feelings
- enjoy working with others to make school a good place to be
- understand why it is good to be kind & use gentle hands
- understand children's rights & that this means we should all be allowed to learn & play
- understand what being responsible means
