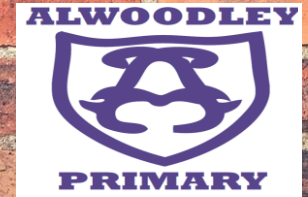


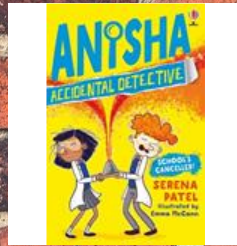
Summer One Term Year 4



English

We will be reading Anisha the Accidental Detective this half term to inspire our writing. Based on the events in the book, we will be writing a character description and a mystery story. At the start of each writing unit, we will explore the features of each text type before creating our own based on the text.

We are reading...



This is a story about Anisha who loves science. With her friends, Govi and Milo, she creates a plan for an erupting volcano. The trio is chosen to represent the school at the science fair but something goes horribly wrong.

Maths

This half term we will be studying Decimals. We will continue to revise and consolidate our times tables through a variety of activities and TT Rockstars ready for the multiplication check in the second week of June.

Science

We will be diving into the fascinating topic of **Sound** as part of our science curriculum. We will explore how sounds are made through vibrations, how they travel through different materials, and why some sounds are louder or higher-pitched than others. We will investigate how sound changes over distance, experiment with ways to insulate or amplify sound, and learn how the human ear helps us to hear. By the end of the unit, pupils will have developed a strong understanding of how sound works in the world around them and will be able to apply their learning through hands-on investigations and simple scientific explanations.

DT

In DT this term, the focus for the children will be food technology. They will look at the recipes for a carrot cake and a Spanish omelette. The children will look at the different ingredients required to make them, designing their food items and how to decorate/present them. Food hygiene will also be studied as part of this exciting topic.



Geography

Our geography unit this term is Trade and how this has impacted Leeds over time. We will learn about trade generally and how this became global. With a focus on Leeds, we will study how trade has developed. The children will look at where the products we buy come from, what a supply chain is and how a supply chain works. We will also study what the UK exports to other countries, including the highest value export. The children will also learn about Fairtrade and the impact Fairtrade has on global trade.

PSHE

Children will look at Relationships this half term. This will include knowing how to make friends, solve friendship issues when they occur, and how to help others feel part of a group. They will also explore how to show respect in front of others, know how to help themselves and others when they feel upset or hurt and know what makes a good relationship.

Music

This half term's topic we will be working towards our Artforms Amber Award. We will need to perform to an audience and take care of our musical instruments!

Computing

This half term, we will be exploring the exciting world of photo editing. We will learn how digital images can be changed and improved using tools such as cropping, rotating, adjusting colours, and combining different pictures. Alongside these practical skills, we will also begin to think about how editing can change the meaning of an image and why it's important to use these tools responsibly. The aim is for pupils to develop confidence as thoughtful digital creators who can use technology to enhance their ideas and communicate effectively.

PE

This half term, both Willow and Hazel will mix for swimming on a Wednesday afternoon. Emails will be sent to those parents whose children will attend swimming lessons. Those children who are not attending swimming will take part in a PE lesson on a Wednesday. The topics for this half term will be Tennis and Athletics
