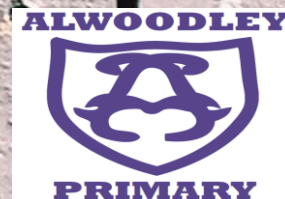


Summer One Term Year 6



English

This half term in English, we will be focusing on developing both our formal and creative writing skills. Pupils will be writing thoughtful thank-you letters to Herd Farm, reflecting on their recent experiences. In addition, we will explore narrative writing by creating suspenseful stories inspired by a silent film, helping children build tension, atmosphere, and engage the reader effectively.

We are reading...



We will also be reading and discussing *Can You See Me?* by Libby Scott. This story follows an autistic girl starting secondary school and explores themes of friendship, inclusion, and understanding. Through this book, pupils will build empathy, discuss important social issues.

Maths

This half term in maths, pupils will take part in an exciting project-based unit where they will design their own theme park. Through this project, children will apply a wide range of mathematical skills, including problem-solving, measurement, budgeting, and data handling, allowing them to see how maths is used in real-life situations in a creative and engaging way.

Science

This half term in science, we will be continuing our unit on light. Pupils will deepen their understanding of how light travels, how we see objects, and how shadows are formed. They will also investigate reflection and refraction through a range of practical activities, developing their scientific enquiry and reasoning skills.

Art

This half term in Art, we will be continuing our graffiti project. Pupils will develop their design skills by creating bold, creative artwork and then applying their final designs to their own t-shirt. This project allows children to express themselves artistically while exploring colour, typography, and street art styles.



Geography

This half term in Geography, we will be studying biomes. Pupils will learn about different types of biomes around the world, including their climates, plants, animals, and locations. They will explore how living things are adapted to their environments and develop their understanding of how climate affects life on Earth.

DT

This half term in Design and Technology, we will be focusing on food and nutrition through a project based on 'Grab & Go' products. Pupils will investigate, design, and evaluate their own convenient, healthy food items suitable for eating on the move. As part of the design process, we may ask children to bring in some picnic-style foods to sample and evaluate, helping them to develop their ideas and understanding of consumer preferences.

PSHE

This half term we will be finishing our learning with our 'relationships' topic. This includes how we feel about ourselves and our self-image as well as relationships with others.

Computing

This half term in Computing, pupils will complete two units focusing on spreadsheets and 3D modelling. They will develop their skills in organising and analysing data using spreadsheets, as well as designing and creating digital 3D models, helping to build their problem-solving and digital creativity skills.

PE

This half term in PE, pupils will be developing their skills in athletics and rounders. They will focus on improving their techniques in running, jumping, and throwing, as well as teamwork, coordination, and game strategies through a range of engaging activities and matches.

RE

This half term in RE, we will be learning about Sikhism. Pupils will explore key beliefs, values, and practices within the Sikh faith, developing their understanding of different religions and cultures. As part of this unit, we will also be visiting a Gurdwara on 23rd June to enhance our learning through a real-life experience.
